GALAXY PLAY DOUGH

Materials

- 2 cups of flour
- 1/2 cup of salt
- 1 & 1/2 cups of boiling water
- 2 tbsp of baby oil
- 2 tbsp cream of tartar
- Black food coloring {or liquid watercolors}
- 3-5 drops of <u>Glycerin</u>
- Glitter (we used purple, sliver, gold, & red)

Note: You can find glycerin in the health & beauty section of most stores

Method

- Combine the flour, salt, & <u>cream of tartar</u> in a bowl and mix well.
- Add several drops of <u>black food coloring</u> to the boiling water, and then combine that in the bowl along with the baby oil & the glycerin. Mix all the ingredients.
- Continue mixing until the play dough is formed, and then knead the dough for several minutes. Add more food coloring as you knead if needed. I used A LOT of food coloring to get the rich, black coloring you see here.
- Once mixed you will now have the most amazing, super stretchy dough!
- Finish the dough by adding glitter in the colors of your choice to mimic the stars in the galaxy.

That's it! Now it is time to PLAY!
